Needs Assessment & Data Review: CCRPI, Climate Survey, Georgia Milestone EOG results, Faculty response from CEIO (Curriculum, Environment, Instruction, and Organization), 5 Whys

School Climate Goal: By May 2018, 100% of teachers will complete training on parent engagement strategies and documented parent involvement will be at least 80% in each homeroom.

Strategies:

Instructional Goal: By May 2018, 85% of teachers will have artifacts as evidence of differentiated instruction targeting non-fiction text for the purpose of student Lexile growth.

Strategies:

- *Implement SmartyAnts and Achieve 3000
- *Group together based on baseline Lexile scores
- *Use non-fiction texts within IB units on all Lexile levels
- *Leveling books based on Lexile scores instead of grade level
- *Develop and host a Family Reading Night
